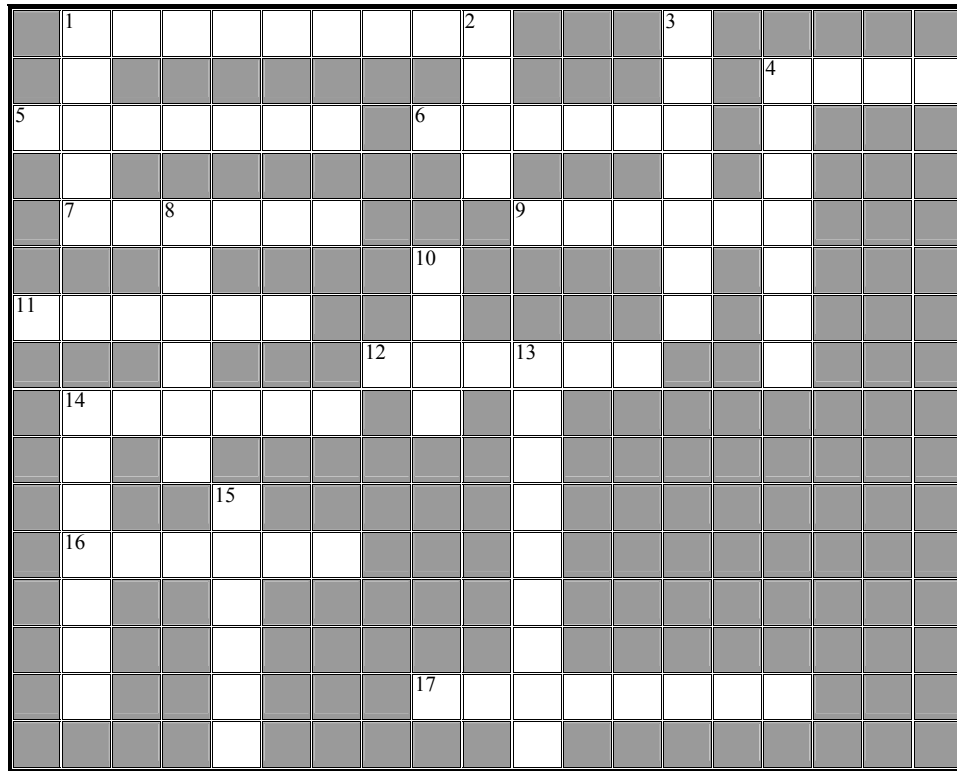


Shakespeare's Crazy Crosswords
