

Painting Books in Colonial Spanish America

There are literally hundreds extant Spanish American colonial paintings and illustrations with images of readers, books, and libraries. Historians have traditionally overlooked these images as primary sources. My talk approaches the history of the book in the Spanish empire by exploring how images shed light on the history of printing, manuscript culture, reading practices, authorship, and the cultural authority of writing.
