now detected of manifeſt treason, euerie man deteſ-
ting his abhominable fact, and wiſhing him to be o-
uerwhelmed in the raging flouds, ſo to paie the due
punifhment, which of right he owght, foꝝ his vile tre-
ſon in murdering his naturall lord.
